

use of any purported trademark and that they, nor any of them, will not recommend or denominate any solely authorized, exclusive source or sources of supply for any jewelry or insignia goods.

2. Phi Delta Theta Fraternity, Sigma Chi Fraternity and Sigma Chi Corporation shall continue to be treated as parties for the sole purpose of the taking of the deposition of their respective executive secretaries and of such additional document discovery as may be ordered by the Court, all such discovery to be conducted in accordance with Rules 26, 30, 34 and 45 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.

3. This Decree and Order of Dismissal shall apply to Phi Delta Theta Fraternity, Sigma Chi Fraternity and Sigma Chi Corporation and J.A. Buchroeder & Co. and to their respective successors, assigns, officers, directors, agents, attorneys, employees and members, but to them only.

4. These actions, and all claims and counterclaims between Phi Delta Theta Fraternity, Sigma Chi Fraternity and Sigma Chi Corporation and J.A. Buchroeder & Co. asserted therein, are hereby dismissed without prejudice and without admission by any party with respect to any of the issues. All other claims or counterclaims as to any other party named in said petitions or who may be named, are reserved and are not affected by this partial dismissal.
